Dear Ms Tree,

I am a resident of your electorate and am writing to seek your views on several important policy issues that will influence my vote at the upcoming election.

Over recent years, I have become increasingly concerned that Australian climate policy has been driven more by political narratives than by balanced scientific debate. In my view, many of the catastrophic claims surrounding climate change have been challenged by evidence and by experts who argue that climate sensitivity, extreme weather projections, and emissions scenarios are routinely overstated. As a result, I question whether policies built upon these assumptions are in Australia's long-term interests.

Against that background, I would appreciate your response to the following questions.

1. Do you believe Australia's current Net Zero policies will deliver meaningful environmental benefits that justify their economic and social costs?
2. If elected, would you support a thorough review of Net Zero policies to assess their impact on Australian households, industry, agriculture, energy security, and national competitiveness?
3. Would you oppose policies that unnecessarily increase electricity prices, undermine reliable energy generation, or reduce Australia's economic resilience in pursuit of emissions targets?
4. What is your position on the United Nations' Agenda 2030 Sustainable Development Goals? Do you regard Agenda 2030 as a useful voluntary framework, or do you believe Australia should maintain complete sovereignty over domestic policy without being guided by international agendas?
5. If international commitments under Agenda 2030 were to conflict with Australia's national interests, would you support prioritising Australian sovereignty and democratic decision-making?
6. Will you support open scientific debate on climate policy and protect the right of Australians to question prevailing climate policies without fear of censorship or professional repercussions?

Many Australians are concerned about the affordability of energy, the rising cost of living, and maintaining reliable electricity while protecting our environment through practical and evidence-based policies. I believe elected representatives should be transparent about where they stand on these issues so that voters can make informed decisions.

I would appreciate a considered response outlining your position on these matters and how you intend to represent the interests of constituents should you be elected.
